

Competition for students in years 5 and 6 of Primary Education.

What should the ideal school of the future be like?

- There will be a maximum number of three students per group. Groups can be made up of students from the same year or from **years 5 and 6 Primary Education from the same school**. In successive years, teams of students from different schools will be encouraged.
- **Each group will be assigned a mentor** who will be a primary teacher, a student of the Diploma Programme or an emeritus teacher.
- Each group will present a work that fits the proposed title.
- **Students can choose the project freely**, it can be a mockup, a PowerPoint presentation, a collage of photos or videos, a 3D work, a robotics development, a virtual reality project, a written statement with a maximum of 2,000 words.
- Final date for submitting entries is the 1 **April 2022**.
- Each school can submit a **maximum of three proposals**.
- A qualifying panel of judges made up of three Baccalaureate teachers will select the best three.
- The three finalist entries will be presented at the **8th Felipe Segovia Symposium**.
- Languages: Spanish and English.
- Each group may present a maximum of one original and unpublished or previously awarded work.
- The names and surnames of the students, year and school to which they belong must be attached.
