## The 26<sup>th</sup> SEK AWARDS

# to Social Commitment, M<sup>a</sup> Rosa Bonet Bargañó

Camilo José Cela University and SEK International Schools – are focussed on the student as the driver of his or her learning and for them to value solidarity as a central aspect of their education.

Social commitment has always been one of SEK's hallmarks and a core aspect of its ideology. An ethos that ensures the all-round education of students, instilling in them social awareness, solidarity and the pragmatic vision young generations should have when faced with global realities.

SEK Educational Group, through the Felipe Segovia Foundation, therefore is holding its Social Commitment Award M<sup>a</sup> Rosa Bonet Bargañó, with the aim of publicly acknowledging the best individual and collective projects carried out by our teaching staff and members of our community, both from within and without our professional environment.

Bearing in mind this consideration, the following terms and conditions have been set:

### FIRST

Prize money: 2,000 euros

### SECOND

Participants: any persons or group pertaining to SEK Group, University and SEK Schools- (teachers, research or teaching staff and non-teaching staff) with a personal or professional track record contributing to, or having an outstanding contribution to, the goals of the award.

### THIRD

Entries must be put forward by members of the SEK community not involved in the candidate project(s).

### FOURTH

Procedure for entries: Candidate projects should be presented along with the following documents on:

- Name and surname, National ID card and contact telephone number of the proposing party.
- Full name of the candidate or candidates and position in the SEK Group.
- Argument in favour of the candidate(s) merits.
- Origin and description of the social work being carried out (where the initiative was born, its history and trajectory, etc.).
- Annexed documents to support the arguments in favour of its merits attributed to the award.
- Difficulties overcome in the activities.

### FIFTH

Awarding criteria: An ad-hoc panel of judges shall be set up made up of different members of the SEK Group, who will objectively and impartially assess the entries, bearing in mind the following criteria:

- Continuity (roots in the community and its continuity over time).
- Impact and significance of the social action.
- Raising of collective awareness (valued contribution to society).

### SIXTH

The prize money may be distributed equally between several finalists.

### SEVENTH

Entries must be submitted before 4 October 2021.

### EIGHTH

The judges may award additional honourable mentions if they wish.

### NINTH

The Judges' decisions are final.

### TENTH

Awards may be declared null and void if entries do not meet suitable standards of quality in terms of the goals established for the award.

### ELEVENTH

Award decisions will be made public before 5 November 2021.

### TWELFTH

The official Award Ceremony will take place during SEK Day 2021-2022.
